Dear all,

Although we are still moving in the right direction, some of our social distancing measures implemented earlier are being extended. In this way, we keep physical contact and the number of people in the waiting room limited in order to maintain safety for all of us. We appreciate your cooperation and flexibility.

Please read carefully the information below!

- We continue to plan appointments on Sloterveerlaan, Hoofdweg and **Burgemeester Fockstraat 57** – please check your Zwangerenportaal if you are not sure about the location
- Partners are welcome again on all prenatal appointments. If your partner is not able to attend you may bring **one** other person.
- **No children, friends or family members** may attend antenatal appointments or scanning. Come alone if possible.
- Please do not come late, but preferably also not too early
- There is a maximum of **4 people** in the waiting room, so that adequate distance (1,5 meters) can be kept. If the waiting room does get too crowded, we will ask you to wait outside until we call you in for your appointment.
- **Wash your hands** with water and soap when entering the practice
- if you have mild **cold-like symptoms** such as a runny nose, sneezing, a sore throat, a cough or a fever above 38 degrees Celsius, we ask you to **stay at home** and give us a call.
